DEMONSTRATOR AGREEMENT

LOCATION & ACCESS

Bicton Village Hall, 71 Church Lane, Bicton, Shrewsbury SY3 8ER

There is a big car park and easy access to the Main Hall of the building.

EQUIPMENT

Main demonstrator lathe - Jet JWL-1221VS lathe with a M33, MT2 taper. The swing over the bed is 14" and between centres is 16" depending on accessories used.

Alternative lathe: Record Nova DVR-XR, which some demonstrators prefer.

If you wish to use the club lathe please advise the Events Secretary.

Chuck: Axminster clubman, however, we suggest you bring your own chucks which you will be familiar with.

We prefer demonstrators to bring their own tools for the demonstration.

Power Tools Cordless tools are preferred but all power tools must be PAT tested and current on the day of the demonstration.

Sanding We have a dust extraction system, but we ask demonstrators to keep their sanding to a minimum.

Smoke, Fumes and Odours: We would prefer that the demonstration do not include a process which may cause the smoke/fire alarms to be set off as they are linked directly to the fire service. No process giving off a dangerous, lingering odour/obnoxious smell is permitted. (eg. Burned wood/chemical spray). **If the demonstration involves burning wood or using chemical sprays this must be discussed with the organisers prior to the event.**

SAFETY & INSURANCE

Risk Assessments: The club have risk assessments in place for events

Insurance: We require all demonstrators to have **Public Liability insurance** to demonstrate to the club. **We take your email confirmation of receipt and acceptance of this agreement to indicate that such cover is in place.**

Audio / Video: We usually set up two video cameras to allow two different views to be projected on two screens. A microphone will be provided.

Photos may be taken of your demonstration. These, along with a report, will be included on printed and digital club communications to members.

Audience: Typically 30 attendees, with a range of abilities from beginners through to very experienced.

Please can you let the Events Secretary know what you will be demonstrating so that it does not conflict with others that have been booked

Timings: A 2-hour demonstration starting at 7pm, with a 30 minute coffee break at a suitable time. The equipment can be set up from 18.30.

Payment. We expect fees and charges to be in line with the recommendations of the Association of Woodturners. We pay mileage at 45p/mile. Any other costs to be agreed in advance.
